

NYS Adult Literacy Library Services Grant Program 2013-2016

Project

The Adult Literacy Library Service Program helps library systems work with libraries and other partners to develop and expand adult literacy programs which will enhance workforce development services in public libraries, improve adult literacy on the job and in the home. The project theme is “Workforce Development at New York Libraries through Public Library Systems.”

\$9,000 will be allocated to MHLS each year for 3 years for this initiative to deliver adult literacy services. Funds will be sub-granted to member libraries that have strong existing relationships with literacy providers **and** have a related infrastructure component (such as a Public Computing Center in the library; a literacy office in the library; the library is in a designated Literacy Zone) on an annual invitational basis. Grant recipients will participate in training for member libraries about the provision of adult literacy services in public libraries.

Budget

- Code 40 – Purchased Services: \$9,000 will be divided among eligible member libraries.
