Due to re-chartering of the library's service area and the successful referendum establishing the Reed Memorial Library District, the library's service population went from 5,650 to 7,643. When the director was hired, the library was in compliance with the Commissioner's Regulation with a service population well below the 7,500 threshold.

In anticipation of the successful re-chartering of the library, the director has been working on completing her graduate degree from an American Library Association accredited library school program. Thirty of the thirty-six required credits have been earned and it is expected the degree will be completed at the end of the spring 2015 semester.
