- 2. Review Committee Charge
  - A. The Committee reviewed its charge.
  - B. The Committee agreed to recommend a revised charge to clarify its role in reviewing policies and procedures in addition to MHLS Bylaws.
  - C. <u>ACTION ITEM</u>: The Bylaws, Policy and Procedures Committee recommends to the MHLS Board of Trustees the approval of a revised Committee charge. Recommended revisions are highlighted below in <u>yellow</u>.

Reviews the MHLS Bylaws and presents a report and recommendations at the Board of Trustees May meeting, following which the board may present its recommendations for amendments at the annual meeting. Reviews and recommends MHLS policies and procedures other than those that are explicitly covered by other committees.

    - A. Mr. Dax reported he had not received any recommendations for changes to the MHLS Bylaws.
    - B. The Committee agreed not to recommend any changes to the MHLS Bylaws.
- 4. Review City of Poughkeepsie's Open Trespass Affidavit
  - A. The Committee discussed the reasons MHLS might establish policy/procedures for enforcing no loitering/no trespassing on MHLS property.
  - B. The Committee reviewed and discussed the City of Poughkeepsie's Open Trespass Affidavit, which MHLS would be required to sign in order for City police to enforce no loitering/trespass on MHLS property.
  - C. The Committee agreed MHLS should not sign the Open Trespass Affidavit primarily because the few incidences of loitering/trespassing did not justify MHLS agreeing to all the terms of the affidavit, and in cases of serious misbehavior, the police have responded promptly and appropriately.
  - D. The Committee suggested the Facilities Committee may wish to review the MHLS loitering/trespassing situation in terms of property management issues.
