MHLS Winter 2017 Weeding Project

a project of the Central Library and Collection Development Advisory Committee

Previous weeding projects have concentrated on the adult nonfiction collections. This time we would like to concentrate on older materials that have not circulated recently, across all collections. This includes books and A/V materials in the adult, juvenile, and teen/YA collections.

The Central Library staff can supply lists of items that have been in your collection for more than a given number of years and that have not circulated in a given number of years. Specifically, we are offering:

- "GEAC/10" – items created in May 2002 or before (basically, under GEAC) and that have not circulated for at least 10 years (not since 12/31/2006)
- "10/10" – items created at least 10 years ago (before 1/1/2007) and that have not circulated for at least 10 years (not since 12/31/2006)
- "10/7" – items created at least 10 years ago (before 1/1/2007) and that have not circulated for at least 7 years (not since 12/31/2009)
- "10/5" – items created at least 10 years ago (before 1/1/2007) and that have not circulated for at least 5 years (not since 12/31/2011)

We can supply the data as printouts, an Excel file, or both.

The project has two aspects:

- Weeding physical materials from the shelves
- Removing item records from Sierra for items no longer on your shelves

What is included on the lists?

The lists:

- Include all item records from your location (A/J/Y) meeting the created and last circ criteria you select
- Do not contain items with a STATUS of "o IN LIBRARY USE"
- Do not contain items with the STATUS of "d DISCARD"
- Include all other STATUS, such as "m MISSING", "n BILLED", "a ASK STAFF", etc.

The Items are sorted in CALL # sequence. If some items seem to be out of order, these are not sorting mistakes, but rather something about the CALL # field itself is not standard. Typical problems are leading blanks or missing author cutters.

What if items from Reference or Local History or special collections are on the list?

Such items will be on the list if they do not have a STATUS of "o IN LIBRARY USE". If you want to keep the items, and if they are listed as "- CHECKED IN", we suggest you change their STATUS to "o IN LIBRARY USE". If

you have a large number of items to change, contact TechSupport at MidHudson for assistance with a global change.

Because all other STATUS values are included on the lists, if some non-circulating items have a status of "a ASK STAFF", these items will appear on the list.

How should we update Sierra for items we are weeding?

Some libraries delete the records, but we think a better approach is to change the following fields in each record:

- Change ANNUAL RPT to "n SUPPRESS ITEM" and
- Change STATUS to "d DISCARD"

With this approach you can pull a create list of all the items you are discarding (useful for insurance or other accounting purposes). The "SUPPRESS" means the item will not display in the OPAC. When you are ready to remove the item records from Sierra, MHLS TechSupport can help you.

If you simply delete the record, then there is no way to obtain information about how much you are removing.

What should we do about items we don't find ?

In a very few cases, the item might be checked out or in transit or on the holdshelf. Look at the details in the item record to see if it is a current circ. You may still want to weed the item when it returns, since before this circ it hadn't gone out for 5 or 7 or 10 years (whatever list you selected).

If the item has a STATUS of "- CHECKED IN" and you don't find the item, and it hasn't gone out in several years, then chances are the item is truly gone, for whatever reason. If you want to have a copy of the item, you will probably have to purchase a new one, and the new copy will probably get a new item record. This item record, for the item you can't find, can be marked for SUPPRESS/DISCARD.

If the item has some other STATUS such as "m MISSING", then you should probably treat it as a weed and change it to SUPPRESS/DISCARD.

See below for special handling for the STATUS values of "n BILLED", "z CLMS RETD" and "\$ LOST AND PAID".

What do the various date fields mean?

- "Created" is the date the item record was added to the database.
- "Pub" is a publication date from the DATE ONE (@266) field of the bib record. The field does not always have a date in it, however.
- If there is a value in OUT DATE, then the item is currently checked out, but its previous circ displays in LOUDDATE. Depending on the file you are using, this date will be at least 5, 7, or 10 years prior to the OUT DATE (meaning the item sat on the shelves for that many years before just going out).
- In most cases, OUT DATE will be empty (" - - "), and LOUDDATE is the date of the most recent circ.
- If LOUDDATE has " - - ", and if OUT DATE is also " - - ", then the item has not circulated since the start of Sierra (formerly Millennium) in 2002 or since the item was added to the system.

- For items added in GEAC (before May 17, 2002), GEAC LCIRC shows either when the item last circulated under GEAC or when the item was added.

What do the various circulation numbers mean?

- If the item record was created under GEAC (generally, May 2002 or before), then TOT includes the circs under GEAC plus the circs under Millennium/Sierra.
- If the item record was created in June 2002 or later, there are no GEAC circs, and TOT represents all the circs since the item was created.
- 945|r is the number of circs under GEAC, so the number of circs under Millennium/Sierra for GEAC items is TOT minus 945|r. This could be useful only if you think you might want to purchase an updated copy of some item that circulated highly in the past, even if it doesn't have recent circs.

What do we do about long-age BILLED items?

BILLED (n) – I thought there used to be a document about how to remove item records for billed items but still leave the charge on the patron record. Checking with techsupport.

What do we do about CLMS RETD items?

CLMS RETD (z) – ask mhls what should be done with these

What do we do about LOST AND PAID items?

LOST AND PAID (\$) – verify this. Since the item has been paid for, can we remove it (disc/sup or just delete???)

How were the lists created?

We first use Sierra Create Lists to obtain, for all libraries, all item records:

- Created before a given date
- That are not DISCARD (STATUS = d) or IN LIBRARY USE (STATUS=o)
- With a LOUDDATE of a given date or before, or a LOUDDATE of empty

For example, this is the "10/10" create list:

Next we export the data and format the Excel files.

Then we separate the files to create individual files for each location.

If you want to create your own with your own dates, just add your LOCATION to the search, for example:

arl no circs 3 years
